If you take injections, this message is for you. Used needles, syringes and lancets are called "sharps". They can cause injuries to your children, friends and neighbors, solid waste handlers and pets. If not

thrown away carefully, these injuries may have the potential to cause infections and diseases like hepatitis and AIDS. Although it is still legal to place sharps in the regular trash, it is im-

perative they are contained properly.

Contact the District for a sharps container. One container is free to each family.

Residents on the Westside of the District will have the convenience of recycling household hazardous waste and used electronics without driving to Ashley. With funds from an IDEM grant, the District will begin promotion of a one-day collection event. Preparations are being made to identify an appropriate location that meets District requirements yet offers convenience and easy access to residents.
