Fees apply.

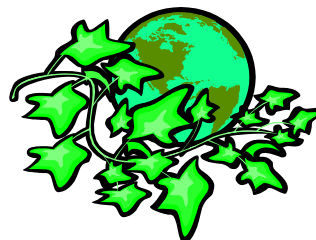
Compost Facilities Open for the Season

Business and Industry Hazardous Waste Program

To meet the needs of small businesses throughout the four-counties within the Northeast Indiana Solid Waste District, a program was established to specifically handle materials from Conditionally Exempt Small Quantity Generators (CESQG's).

CESQG's are facilities that produce less than 100 kg (220 lbs) of Hazardous Waste per month.

This service introduces CESQG's to the proper procedures of recycling and/or disposal of hazardous waste materials found within their companies. Fees established under the current District contract will be applied to your business. An administrative fee of 20% will also be charged to allow the District to continue to assist with handling of material and costs associated with recycling and/or disposal.

All the CESQG needs to do is contact our office for an appointment to deliver materials. Friday morning is the only day we operate this program. Upon receipt, processing and transportation is completed, we will send an invoice and certification paperwork for your records. Feel free to browse our website to become familiar with additional programs and services.
