How that one step is accomplished is multi-faceted.

Pollution prevention & waste minimization services—

development of environmentally friendly procedures for the workplace.

Recycling services—innovative partnerships handle recycling, problem waste and electronic recycling programs. Using the public/private partnership approach allows the NISWMD to maximize not only our own resources but leverage those resources of the private sector as well.

Education and public information services—handled through a myriad of media and presentations to individuals and groups of all sizes.

Composting services—residents and landscape contractors alike benefit from this program. Compost lots are open 62 hours per week offering a location to recover yard clippings, brush and leaves. Screened compost and wood mulch is also available for a small fee.

Solid waste planning services—development and implementation of programs and services.

Legislative and governmental services—the ability of keeping current on the day-to-day happenings with regard to environmental issues.

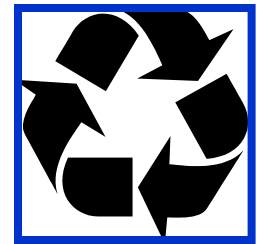
**Household Problem Waste Collection
