Natural Resource	Products
1. iron ore	plastics and fuel
2. cotton plant	clothing, such as T-shirts or jeans
3. trees	steel cans, cars, and bridges
4. bauxite ore	aluminum cans and airplanes
5. petroleum	wires and pipes
6. gold	jewelry and electronics
7. chromium	stainless steel
8. diamonds	jewelry and cutting tools
9. sand (silica)	paper, boxes, and furniture
10. copper	glass bottles and jars
